Work Schedule

Coaches must have a flexible schedule and be able to attend all practices, games, tournaments, and other job duties (as applicable).

Contracted hours for OCA teachers are 7:30 AM – 4:30 PM Mondays; 7:30 AM – 4:00 PM Tuesday through Friday, as coordinated through the individual teacher contract; and all required Inservice days, conferences and school events that may lie outside of those core hours, unless otherwise approved by school Administrator. Flexibility to the contracted teaching hours is acceptable to appropriately coordinate with coaching hours, should you be hired for a teaching role as well.

Job Description

- Maintain communication with parents/guardians on activity schedules, updates, and requirements of the students/team.
- Demonstrate excellent organizational skills, time management, both written and verbal communication, and interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrate the ability to appropriately manage game/performance statistics and scorekeeping.

Physical and Mental Demands:
