

2022 – 2023 Private Instrumental/Voice Lessons

Information and Lesson Request Form

- Private Music Lessons are available at Omaha Christian Academy.
 - Arrangements must be made through the Music Department so that lesson times and be coordinated with the classroom teacher and the music teacher. This arrangement also keeps the office informed of the student's whereabouts for emergencies.
 - Great effort is made to schedule lessons during recess, music class, study hall or after school.
 - If a student has to miss part of an academic time for a lesson, the parents will be notified, and will be expected to help their student complete the classroom work.
 - The music teacher will assist in getting the student to the correct place for the first time or two, then, it will be the student's responsibility to remember and get there.
 - **Students should come with their lesson books and instrument on their scheduled day.** If the student forgets their books/instrument, the teacher will have flash cards and music theory work for the student. This should be the exception, however!
- 30 minute lessons are **\$16.00** per session. Students are able to have 15-18 lessons per semester. Teachers are to be paid on the first lesson of every month. **Do not pay Omaha Christian Academy for these lessons.** Payment will be made directly to the respective teacher.
- Lessons missed because of absence, field trips, or school vacation **will not** be charged and may or may not be rescheduled depending on availability.
 - Lessons missed because of negligence **will** be charged. Please do not schedule non-urgent Doctor, Dentist or Orthodontist appointments during the lesson time. The teacher has reserved that time for the student.
 - Occasionally, students may wish to drop lessons. Please try to continue with lessons until the end of a semester. However, lessons may be terminated provided there is a one month written notice given to the teacher.
 - Please use the Piano Lesson Form (Green) if you desire Piano Lessons for your student.
 - Instrumental Lessons can begin in 5th grade (student's desiring to play a string instrument can and should begin in an earlier grade).
 - **All Band students are encouraged to take private lessons.**
 - Voice Lessons are recommended for Sr. High Choir students.
