- Demonstrate excellent organizational skills, time management, both written and verbal communication, and interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrate the ability to utilize, or the capacity to learn, classroom technology such as the use of computers, tablets or Chromebooks, copiers, scanners, and SMART boards.
