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CHRISTIAN ROLE MODEL

The faculty/staff/board member will manifest by precept and example the highest Christian virtue and personal decorum, serving as a **Christian role model** (I Timothy 4:12) both in and out of school to pupils (Luke 6:40), and as an example to parents and fellow faculty/staff/board members in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living. This includes, but is not limited to, the refraining from such activities as the use of tobacco, illicit drugs, vulgar and profane language, and the misuse of alcohol (Colossians 3:17; Titus 2:7-8; I Thessalonians 2:10; 5:18, 22-23, and James 3:17-18).

The faculty/staff/board member agrees that the Scripture dictates standards of sexual behavior. Sexual misconduct as defined in the statement below is cause for dismissal from OCA. Any promiscuity, homosexuality, or other deviant sexual behavior is forbidden and as such violates the bona fide occupational requirement of being a <u>Christian role model</u>. The unique roles of the male and female are clearly defined in Scripture. Romans 1:24-32 states that God recognizes homosexuals and other deviates as perverted. Such deviation from Scriptural standards is grounds for termination (Romans 12:1-2; I Corinthians 6:9-20; Ephesians 4:1-11, 5:3-5; I Thessalonians 4: 3-8; I Timothy 4:12; II Timothy 2:19-22; I Peter 1:15-16, 2:15-17; I John 3:1-3).

Proof of deviation from scriptural standards as determined by the Board is grounds for termination. If an allegation is made, the individual in question will be removed from his/her position immediately until a full investigation has been completed.

Sexual misconduct is defined as:

- Child sexual abuse includes, but is not limited to, any contact or interaction between a student and an adult when the student is being used for the sexual stimulation of the adult person or of a third person. The behavior may or may not involve touching. Sexual behavior between a student and an adult is always considered forced whether consented to by the student or not.
- 2) Sexual harassment is unwelcome sexual advances, request for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature when: a) Submission to such conduct is made either explicitly or implicitly a term or a condition of an individual's employment or their continued status in school; b) Submission to or rejection of such conduct by an individual is used as the basis for employment decisions affecting such individual; or c) Such conduct has the purpose or effect of unreasonalbe interfering with an individual's work performance by creating an intimidating, hostie, or offensive working environment.
- 3) Rape or sexual contact by force, threat, or intimidation.
- 4) Sexual conduct (such as offensive, obscene, or suggestive language or behavior, unacceptable visual contact, unwelcome touching or fondling, possession on school property of pornographic or sexually graphic materials, accessing pornographic or sexually graphic web sites on school property) that is offensive or injurious to the physical or emotional health of another.
- 5) Sexual malfeasance is defined as sexual conduct within a ministerial or professional relation. Sexual conduct includes unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature. This definition is not meant to cover relationships between spouses, nor is it meant to restrict school professionals from having normal, mutual, social, intimate, or marital relationships.

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STATEMENT OF FAITH

As an inter-church school, OCA seeks to unify believers by emphasizing the basic Biblical truths of salvation. We recognize the Bible as God's complete revelation and accept no extra-Biblical teaching as its equal. We interpret the Scriptures literally in a normative, grammatical sense.

OCA accepts students from families that agree with the basic Biblical truths for salvation presented in this Statement of Faith. Those that serve the Lord as board members, faculty, and staff at OCA must be in total agreement with this Statement of Faith. If they change their views, they are expected to terminate their ministry at OCA. OCA seeks to maintain unity by emphasizing salvation by the grace of God through Jesus Christ rather than oppose differences. Final Authority for Matter of Belief and Conduct

The Statement of Faith does not exhaust the extent of our beliefs. The Bible itself, as the inspired and infallible Word of God that speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of mankind, is the sole and final source of all that we believe. For purposes of Omaha Christian Academy's faith, doctrine, practice, policy, and discipline, our School Board is OCA's final interpretive authority on the Bible's meaning and application.

- 1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:21).
- 2. We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons- Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1, Matthew 28:19, John 10:30).
- 3. We believe in the deity of Christ (John 10:33), His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, Luke 1:35), His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15, 7:26), His miracles (John 2:11), His vicarious and atoning death (1 Corinthians 15:3, Ephesians 1:7, Hebrews 2:9), His Resurrection (John 11:25, 1 Corinthians 15:4), His Ascension to the right hand of God (Mark 16:19), His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Revelation 19:11).
- 4. We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature and that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone are we saved (John 3:16-19, 5:24; Romans 3:23, 5:8-9; Ephesians 2:8-10; Titus 3:5).
- 5. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; that they are saved unto the resurrection of life, and that they are lost unto the resurrection of condemnation (John 5:28-29).
- 6. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (romans 8:9, 1 Corinthians 2:12-13, Galatians 3:26-28).
- 7. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Romans 8:13-14; 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19-20; Ephesians 4:30, 5:18).
- 8. We believe that the term marriage has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture (Genesis 2:18-25). We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other (1 Corinthians 6:18, 7:2-5; Hebrews 13:4).
- 9. We believe that God's command is that there be no sexual intimacy outside of or apart from marriage between a man and a woman.
- 10. We believe that God wonderfully foreordained and immutably created each person as either male or female in conformity with their biological sex. These two distinct yet complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God (Genesis 1:26-27).
